





Percentage of undocumented killings





#### Internet (DSL, 3G, and 2G) accessibility


by Syrian governorate, June 2013 - April 2014

#### Internet restrictions & the choice of violence

Expected proportion of targeted killings, given internet (DSL) accessibility

#### Take-Away

In governorates where internet fully accessible  $\Rightarrow$  1 in 4 targeted killings.

In governorates with no internet  $\Rightarrow$  less than 1 in 10 targeted killings.

⇒ Higher internet accessibility linked to more targeted killings, lower accessibility linked to more untargeted violence

In governorates with no internet  $\Rightarrow$  less than 1 in 10 targeted killings.

 $\Rightarrow$  Higher internet accessibility linked to more targeted killings, lower accessibility linked to more untargeted violence
